WHEREAS, on December 12, 2025, the City Manager authorized by Administrative Action No. 25-6670, a six-month master subscription agreement with Govolution, LLC and the City through the City Controller's Office to provide internet-based electronic payment services using third party proprietary software applications for the purpose of processing credit card and/or ACH payments, in an amount not to exceed \$242,573.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a master subscription and service agreement with Govolution, LLC (VS0000005137), approved as to form by the City Attorney, for the period of June 16, 2026 through June 17, 2027, for internet-based electronic payment services using third party proprietary software applications for the purpose of processing credit card and/or ACH payments, in an estimated amount of \$824,749. The amount payable pursuant to this master subscription and service agreement may exceed the estimated amount but may not exceed the amount of budgetary appropriations for this master subscription and service agreement during its term. Payments made to Govolution, LLC shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by Govolution, LLC under the master subscription and service agreement. The City Manager is further authorized, in the City Manager's sole discretion, to exercise an option to extend the agreement for six months by filing a notice of extension with the City Secretary's Office.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an estimated amount of \$824,749 (subject to annual appropriations), but not more than the amount of budgetary appropriations for this master subscription and service agreement during its term to Govolution, LLC from Master Subscription Agreement Contract No. CCO-2026-00030165.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly resolved.
