



Dallas Street Response Outcomes March 2026

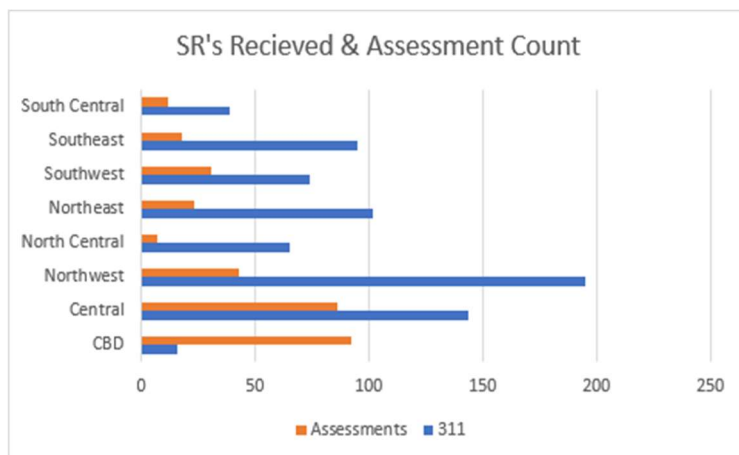
Emergency Management & Crisis Response

Key Highlights

- 730 service requests related to homeless encampments received
- 313 outreach & encampment assessment reports completed
- 84 encampment cleanups coordinated with Transportation & Public Works
 - 10 were conducted with Hazmat vendors
- 106 shelter/housing referrals and 31 law enforcement referrals
- 66 notices to vacate issued

Key Takeaway: The **730 service requests** represent all calls, emails, and app submissions related to encampments across Dallas. March 2026 service requests received are a **35.0% reduction** compared to March 2025. After removing duplicates and combining reports about the same site, the team completed **313 outreach & encampment assessments**, each representing a unique, verified location where outreach or encampment activity was observed.
