WHEREAS, on March 2, 2026, City Attorney Tammy L. Palomino notified City Council of her retirement effective at the close of business on April 30, 2026; and

WHEREAS, City Council determined that it is necessary to appoint an Interim City Attorney during the time it takes to select and appoint a new City Attorney; and

WHEREAS, on April 21, 2026, the Ad Hoc Committee on Administrative Affairs discussed and provided a recommendation to the City Council on the appointment of an Interim City Attorney.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That _____ is hereby appointed Interim City Attorney, effective at the close of business on April 30, 2026, to serve until City Council selects and appoints the City Attorney. During this interim appointment period, _____ shall have the full powers and duties of the City Attorney as provided in the City Charter and ordinances and shall be paid an annual base salary of \$_____ while serving in this capacity.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
