WHEREAS, on May 13, 2020, the City Council authorized (1) a one-year service price agreement with Pacify Health, Inc dba Pacify to provide City residents with access to twenty-four-hour on demand lactation support through the Office of Community Care and Empowerment in an estimated amount of \$136,380.00; and (2) the ratification of \$63,782.50 to pay outstanding invoices for a total estimated amount of \$200,162.50, by Resolution No. 20-0736; and

WHEREAS, on April 13, 2022, the City Council authorized a service price agreement with Pacify Health, Inc dba Pacify to provide City residents with access to twenty-four-hour on demand lactation support through the Office of Community Care and Empowerment for a term of three years, in an estimated amount of \$409,140.00, by Resolution No. 22-0574; and

WHEREAS, on August 14, 2024, the City Council authorized the acceptance of grant from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) for the Texas Lactation Support After-Hours Hotline (TLSAH) Program in the amount of \$400,000.00 to fund the after-hours lactation support services for the period of September 1, 2024 through August 31, 2025, by Resolution No. 24-1076; and

WHEREAS, on June 25, 2025, the City Council authorized acceptance of additional grant funds in an amount of \$400,000.00 from DSHS for the TLSAH Program for the period September 1, 2025 through August 31, 2026, by Resolution No. 25-1057; and

WHEREAS, on August 27, 2025, the City Council authorized (1) a one-year service price agreement with Pacify Health, Inc dba Pacify to provide City residents with access to twenty-four-hour on demand lactation support through the Office of Community Care and Empowerment in an estimated amount of \$174,180.00, by Resolution No. 25-1326; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds there is a public purpose in providing twenty-four-hour on demand lactation support to assist in enhancing community health and well-being; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas seeks to enter into a one-year contract with Pacify Health, Inc dba Pacify in providing City residents with access to twenty-four-hour on demand lactation support.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a service price agreement with Pacify Health, Inc dba Pacify, approved as to form by the City Attorney, to provide City residents with access to twenty-four-hour on demand lactation support through the Office of Housing and Community Empowerment for a term of one year, for the period September 1, 2026 through August 31, 2027 in an estimated amount of \$174,180.00. The amount payable pursuant to this service price agreement may exceed the estimated amount but may not exceed the amount of budgetary appropriations for this service price agreement during its term. Payments made to Pacify Health, Inc dba Pacify shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by Pacify Health, Inc dba Pacify under the service price agreement. The City Manager is further authorized, in the City Manager's sole discretion, to exercise an option to extend the agreement for six months by filing a notice of extension with the City Secretary's Office.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an estimated amount not to exceed \$174,180.00 to Pacify Health, Inc dba Pacify from the FY27 Texas Lactation Support After-Hours Hotline Fund, Fund S455, Department HCE, Unit 685S, Various Objects in Encumbrance/Contract No. WIC-2026-00030466, Vendor VS99456.

SECTION 3. That this resolution does not constitute a binding agreement upon the City or subject the City to any liability or obligation with respect to these transactions until such a time as the documents are duly approved by all parties and executed.

SECTION 4. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
