**WHEREAS**, House Bill (HB) 500 from the 89th Texas Legislative Session appropriated \$1,038,000,000.00 from the general revenue fund to the Texas Water Development Board for water infrastructure and supply projects and grants as determined by the board; and

**WHEREAS**, the Texas Water Development Board's Water Supply and Infrastructure Grant (WSIG) Program provides financial assistance for essential water infrastructure improvements that enhance system reliability, reduce water loss, and promote long-term water supply resilience in the form of 100 percent grants; and

**WHEREAS**, the Dallas Water Utilities Department is seeking financial assistance from the Texas Water Development Board through the WSIG Program and intends to submit an application by July 30, 2026; and

**WHEREAS**, the Texas Water Development Board requires Council approval to submit grant applications through the WSIG Program.

**Now, Therefore,**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:**

**SECTION 1.** That the City Manager and the Director of the Dallas Water Utilities Department (or his/her designee) are hereby authorized to represent the City of Dallas while seeking financial assistance through the WSIG Program from the Texas Water Development Board.

**SECTION 2.** That the designated representatives are authorized to apply for grant funding not to exceed \$55,000,000.00 from the Texas Water Development Board under the WSIG Program for essential water infrastructure improvements that enhance system reliability, reduce water loss, and promote long-term water supply resilience.

**SECTION 3.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
