WHEREAS, the City of Dallas's Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) Program has operated for more than 35 years, providing supplemental nutritional information in the form of nutrition services, nutritious foods and referrals to appropriate health and human services; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) has offered a grant to the City of Dallas for the Texas Lactation Support After-Hours Hotline (TLSAH) Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the TLSAH Program will provide a statewide no-fee assistance service offering after-hours clinical lactation support, triage, referral, resource sharing, and general and clinical breastfeeding information through telephone counseling by International Board-Certified Lactation Consultants (IBCLCs) to service recipients; and

WHEREAS, on August 14, 2024, the City Council authorized a contract to accept a grant from the DSHS for the Texas Lactation Support After-Hours Hotline Grant (Contract No. HHS001465500001) (Agreement) in the amount of \$400,000.00 to fund the after-hours lactation support services for the WIC Program for FY 2025 for the period from September 1, 2024 to August 31, 2025, by Resolution No. 24-1076; and

WHEREAS, on June 25, 2025, the City Council authorized a first amendment to the Agreement to accept additional grant funds in the amount of \$400,000.00 to fund the after-hours lactation support services for the WIC Program for a total amount not to exceed \$800,000.00 and extend the Agreement term through August 31, 2026, by Resolution No. 25-1057; and

WHEREAS, there is a continued need for the Lactation Support Center Services Strategic Expansion Program in the City of Dallas; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas desires to accept additional grant funds for the TLSAH Program; and

WHEREAS, the increased amount of this second amendment will not exceed \$360,000.00, increasing the total Agreement amount from \$800,000.00 to \$1,160,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas will benefit in this contract for the FY 2027 grant allocation.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is authorized to execute a second amendment to a contract with the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) (Contract No. HHS001465500001) for the Texas Lactation Support After-Hours Hotline Grant Program for no-fee assistance services for lactating mothers in an amount not to exceed \$360,000.00, increasing the contract amount from \$800,000.00 to \$1,160,000.00 and increasing the term of the contract period from September 1, 2024 through August 31, 2027 and to execute any and all documents required for such acceptance and receipt of funds and all terms, conditions, and documents required by the contract, approved as to form by the City Attorney.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to establish appropriations in an amount not to exceed \$360,000.00 in the FY27 Texas Lactation Support After-Hours Hotline Fund, Fund S455, Department HCE, Unit 685S, various Object Codes, according to **Attachment A**.

SECTION 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to receive and deposit grant funds from the DSHS in an amount not to exceed \$360,000.00 in the FY27 Texas Lactation Support After-Hours Hotline Fund, Fund S455, Department HCE, Unit 685S, Revenue Code 6509.

SECTION 4. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse grant funds in an amount not to exceed \$360,000.00 from the FY27 Texas Lactation Support After-Hours Hotline Fund, Fund S455, Department HCE, Unit 685S, various Object Codes, according to **Attachment A**.

SECTION 5. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to provide additional information and take other actions or adjust the grant budget as may be necessary to satisfy DSHS requirements.

SECTION 6. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to reimburse the granting agency any expenditures identified as ineligible. The City Manager shall notify the appropriate City Council Committee of expenditures identified as ineligible not later than 30 days after the reimbursement.

SECTION 7. That the City Manager or designee is authorized to execute change orders or amendments to the agreement, in an amount not to exceed a total of 25 percent of the original contract amount (subject to compliance with the applicable procurement law), or for time to commit and expend funds in a timely manner to meet federal and/or state requirements when necessary.

SECTION 8. That the City Manager shall keep the appropriate City Council Committee informed of all final DSHS monitoring reports no later than 30 days after the receipt of each such report.

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SECTION 9. That this contract is designated as Contract No. WIC-2026-00030672.

SECTION 10 That this resolution shall take effect immediately and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
