WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) has made funding available to the City of Dallas, under the FY 2025 Homeland Security Grant Program to build our capacity to prevent, protect against, respond to, and recover from a terrorist attack or natural disaster; and

WHEREAS, grant funds will be used for operating expenses related to emergency preparedness and response activities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas will benefit from increased preparedness throughout the city and region.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to accept a grant from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security Federal Emergency Management Agency passed through the Texas Office of the Governor Homeland Security Grants Division (HSGD) for the FY 2025 Homeland Security Grant Program which includes the Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) (Federal / State Award ID No. EMW-2025-SS-05028, Grant Nos. 2980507, 2979907, 3418209, 3698808, 2980311, 3176410, and 4902603, Assistance Listing No. 97.067) in the amount of \$5,582,137.61 to provide funding for activities related to enhancing preparedness and building capacity to prepare for, prevent, and respond to terrorist attacks, and a new Process Improvement Analyst position for the period January 1, 2026 through August 31, 2027; and execute the grant agreement with HSGD and all terms, conditions, and documents required by the agreement, approved as to form by the City Attorney.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to establish appropriations in an amount not to exceed \$3,670,409.84 in the DHS 2025 Homeland Security UASI Fund, Fund F832, Department MGT, Unit 688J, Object 3099.

SECTION 3. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to establish appropriations in an amount not to exceed \$1,911,727.77 in the DHS 2025 Homeland Security UASI Fund, Fund F832, Department MGT, Unit 688K, Object 3099.

SECTION 4. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to receive and deposit funds in an amount not to exceed \$3,670,409.84 in the DHS 2025 Homeland Security UASI Fund, Fund F832, Department MGT, Unit 688J, Revenue Code 6506.

SECTION 5. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to receive and deposit funds in an amount not to exceed \$1,911,727.77 in the DHS 2025 Homeland Security UASI Fund, Fund F832, Department MGT, Unit 688K, Revenue Code 6506.

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SECTION 6. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$3,670,409.84 in the DHS 2025 Homeland Security UASI Fund, Fund F832, Department MGT, Unit 688J, Object 3099.

SECTION 7. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$1,911,727.77 in the DHS 2025 Homeland Security UASI Fund, Fund F832, Department MGT, Unit 688K, Object 3099.

SECTION 8. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to reimburse to the Office of the Governor any expenditure identified as ineligible or in the event of loss of funds. The City Manager shall notify the appropriate City Council Committee of expenditures identified as ineligible not later than 30 days after the reimbursement.

SECTION 9. That the City Manager shall keep the appropriate City Council Committee informed of all final granting agency monitoring reports not later than 30 days after the receipt of the report.

SECTION 10. the City of Dallas designates the Chief Financial Officer as the grantee's financial officer. The financial officer is given the power to submit financial and/or programmatic reports or alter a grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

SECTION 11. That the City of Dallas designates the City Manager or designee as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

SECTION 12. That the City Manager or their designee is authorized to provide additional information, make adjustments, and take other actions related to the implementation or termination of the grant as may be necessary to satisfy the DHS and the Federal Emergency Management Agency.

SECTION 13. That this contract is designated as Contract No. ECR-2026-00030947.

SECTION 14. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
