WHEREAS, a lawsuit, styled Jose Carlos Hernandez v. City of Dallas, Cause No. CC-24-03785-E, was filed by the plaintiff, Jose Carlos Hernandez, seeking compensation from the City of Dallas for alleged bodily injuries and other damages sustained in a motor vehicle accident on November 30, 2022, involving a Department of Sanitation Services employee operating a city-owned vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the plaintiff, Jose Carlos Hernandez, has agreed to a proposed settlement of his claims whereby the City will pay Jose Carlos Hernandez, Hernandez, Medina, and Baggett, PLLC, and all other persons having an interest in the settlement proceeds, the total amount of \$85,000.00; and

WHEREAS, it is in the City's best interest to settle this lawsuit.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the proposed settlement of the lawsuit styled, Jose Carlos Hernandez v. City of Dallas, Cause No. CC-24-03785-E, in an amount not to exceed \$85,000.00 is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to pay Jose Carlos Hernandez, Hernandez, Medina, and Baggett, PLLC, and all other persons having an interest in the settlement proceeds, the total amount of \$85,000.00 from Liability Reserve Fund, Fund 0192, Department ORM, Unit 3890, Object 3521, Vendor MVORM001.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly resolved.
